TRANSFERS

Transfers for Trial 1 must be received in writing by the Trial Secretary no later than 6 p.m. on MONDAY, October, 9, 2023 (transfers by email to *bonniefrank625@gmail.com* are acceptable.) Transfers allowed, but limited within 8 hours of judging. No Transfers to Detective class.

DOGS ELIGIBLE TO ENTER

This trial is open to all dogs six (6) months of age or older that are registered with the American Kennel Club or that have AKC Limited Registration, Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP). An AKC Canine Partners listing number or approved Foundation Stock Service (FSS) breeds are also eligible to participate.

Dogs with a Purebred Alternative Listing/Indefinite Listing Privileges (PAL/ILP) or an AKC Canine Partners listing number must be spayed or neutered in order to complete.

Wherever the word "dog" is used in these regulations, it includes both sexes.

Dogs with physical challenges (including amputees) are eligible to participate provided that, in the opinion of the judge, the dog displays no sign of physical discomfort and can safely complete the search. Deaf and blind dogs are allowed to enter. Females in season may not participate. Aggressive dogs or dogs suffering from an injury or illness which may affect the dog's physical or mental performance may not participate. No dog shall compete if it is sutured, bandaged, or has any visible wounds.

WAIT LIST INFORMAITON

Dauphin Dog Training Club is offering a wait list to fill openings created by withdrawn entries after the trial's closing date/time. A maximum of **20 entries per trial** will be placed on the club's wait list. All entries, including wait listed entries, must be received by the Trial Secretary on or before closing—**September 30, 2023 at 6:00 p.m.** From September 30, 2023, at 6:01 p.m. to October 9, 2023 at 6:00 p.m., full refunds will be given for withdrawn entries when a waitlist entry is able to replace the withdrawn entry. Checks for entry fees will not be deposited until the closing date. Checks for entries that are not accepted in the trials will be shredded.

STAGING AREA, HANDLERS' BRIEFING, AND WARM-UP AREA

The **Staging Area** will be out of view of search area(s). Staging Area will include crating, warm-up, and waiting area, as well as the secretary's table for check-ins and posting of running order and results.

The **Handlers' Briefing** will take place in view of the search area prior to the start of each class, after the hide(s) have been set and after the Demo Dog has run. In the Handlers' Briefing the judge will explain if there is an off-leash option, number of hides, maximum height of hides, and maximum time for the search. **NO DOGS are to be present during the Handlers' Briefing.**A **Warm-Up Area** will be available consisting of one labeled container per target odor and may also consist of blank containers. Exhibitors should limit their warm-up to two (2) minutes or less. The warm-up area is to be used exclusively for warming up the handler-dog team prior to their run. The warm-up area is not for training or relieving of the dog.

SEARCH AREA AND RING CONDITIONS

Search Areas may be of any shape and of the size specified in the Regulations for each class. **Search Area Conditions**—Searches may be indoors, on matted, carpeted, or tiled surfaces, or outdoors on grass, gravel, earth, concrete, or asphalt surfaces. **Search Area Sizes** will be as defined in the AKC Scent Work Regulations.

ADDITIONAL SITE INFORMATION

Trial Site. It is not appropriate to scout the trial location prior to the trial date. Many search locations are real-life environments, and such visits may risk the host losing the opportunity to use the location in the future.

Possession of Odors and Training. Chapter 5, Section 35 of the Scent Work Regulations state, "No person other than those engaged in the administration of a trial shall be in possession of any target odor when on the trial grounds. There shall be no training on the grounds of the AKC Scent Work trial, other than the designated warm-up area."

Spectator Area. Due to Covid-19, spectators will be limited to Exterior Searches. Any person not handling a dog in the current class or any person who has already completed their run in the class may choose to watch the search from the spectator area. Handlers may not watch other exhibitors from their class prior to their run. No one outside the search area may assist the handler or disclose the location of the hide. Spectators who intentionally or unintentionally give aid to a team may be asked to leave the area by the judge. Spectators are forbidden to discuss details of the search with handlers who have not run.

Exhibitors are responsible for cleaning up after their dog(s). Any exhibitor failing to do so may be excused without benefit of refund if the Event Committee deems the exhibitor to be in violation of this requirement. Cleaning supplies and disposal sites will be available and marked.

RIBBONS, AWARDS, AND PRIZES

A **New Title rosette** will be awarded to all dog and handler teams finishing a title. In addition, special tabs for attaching to the New Title rosettes are available for teams earning a Basic Level title or Elite Level title. No High in Trial or High Combined will be offered.

All exhibitors should obtain a copy of Regulations for Scent Work Trials by downloading them from the American Kennel Club website (www.akc.org).

Judging Program will be sent to exhibitors via email after the trials close.

SAFETY, BEHAVIOR, AND LIABILITY

The safety of the dog is our primary concern. By entering this trial, exhibitors acknowledge that they are familiar with the rules and regulations of this sport, and that their dogs are familiar with and able to perform all searches safely. It is expressly understood that exhibitors alone are responsible for the behavior of their dogs and/or children. Any exhibitor whose dogs and/or children create an unnecessary disturbance or repeatedly engage in unsafe or disruptive behavior may, at the discretion of the trial committee, be asked to leave the trial site. In such case, no refund of any fees paid will be made. The Dauphin Dog Training Club and its agents, employees, etc., will assume no responsibilities for any loss, damage, or injury sustained by exhibitors or handlers, or to any of their dogs or property, and further assumes no responsibility of injury to children. The Dauphin Dog Training Club reserves the right to decline entries for cause and may remove any dog on account of aggression. No one shall have any recourse or claim against the Dauphin Dog Training Club or any official thereof.

Collars, Leashes, and Harnesses. During searches, dogs must wear a properly fitted collar or harness approved by the judge. A wearable camera such as a GoPro may be mounted to the dog's harness, if desired. Leashes may be of any length and/or retractable. The leash should be made of plain, pliable material.

All dogs must be on leash at all times, and retractable leashes may not be used when on trial grounds (except during judged searches). Dogs must enter and exit the search area with the leash attached to the collar or harness, including when waiting in the search area before and after the search. An off-leash option may be offered at the discretion of the judge, only if the area is completely enclosed.

REFUNDS

No entry fee will be refunded if the trial cannot open or be completed by reason of riots, civil disturbances, fire, an act of God, public emergency, act of a public enemy, or any other cause beyond the control of the organizing committee. No entry fee will be refunded in the event a dog is absent, disqualified, excused, or barred from competition by the action of the Trial Committee. Dogs pulled after closing because of injury or other medical conditions are not eligible for a refund unless their spot can be filled by an entry on the wait list.

Bitches in season will be refunded the full entry fee. Notification in writing (including a veterinarian's certificate) must be given to the trial secretary no later than on half hour prior to the start of the first class of the day of the trial.

RINGSIDE

Judges are not required to wait for dogs. The owner of each dog is solely responsible for having it ready at the search area when it is to be judged. The club has no responsibility to provide service through a public address system, or stewards, or runners, for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when required.

Exhibitor check-in is self-check-in. Once the time and location for check-in is determined, all exhibitors will be notified by email. **Exhibitors MUST check in for EACH trial in which they are entered.**

Claims will not be arbitrated as set forth on the Official AKC Entry Form for this event.

Exhibitors should follow their veterinarian's recommendation to ensure their dogs are free of internal and external parasites, any communicable diseases, and have appropriate vaccinations.

From the Regulations – CHAPTER 2 Section 2. Class Eligibility

- Novice A Classes are open to dogs who have not completed any title for that particular element, who have not completed a
 comparable title with another organization, and whose handlers are neither Scent Work judges, nor have ever worked as
 professional detection dog handlers.
- Novice B Classes are open to all dogs.
- Advanced Classes are open to dogs who have achieved the Novice title for that particular element.
