9:00 am - 12:00 noon - On the Flat: Handling skills for puppies/young and inexperienced dogs. Exercises to teach the dog handling cues and skills.

1:00 pm - 4:00 pm - Turns and Crosses: Turns and Crosses – wrap, rear cross – over the jump and on the flat, blind cross, front cross. How to use your body appropriately to maximize these skills and when to use them.

9:00 am - 12:00 noon - Choices: Sequences with options.... Which one is better for you and your dog.

1:00 pm - 4:00 pm - In The Moment: For dogs and handlers trialing at the Excellent/Masters level. Any handling challenge can be incorporated into the sequences, i.e., backsides, treadles, serpentine, pull throughs, challenging weave entries, bidirectional jumps, blind tunnel entries, layering
