## NOTICE TO EXHIBITORS

**ENTRY FEE:** Friday \$25 for first entry, \$20 for second entry of same dog, same trial.

**Saturday entry \$30/\$25 second entry for the same dog, same trial.**

**Sunday Rally entry fees are \$30/\$25. Rally cannot be used as a second entry in combination with Obedience. There are two rally trials on Sunday, discounted entries can only apply to the same trial of the first entry. JUNIOR HANDLER FEE – 1<sup>st</sup> entry - \$15.00, 2<sup>nd</sup> entry of same dog same trial - \$10 (Canadian Exhibitors make fees payable in US funds)**

AKC RECORDING FEE OF 50¢ & an AKC Event Service Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each dog entered at any Licensed or Member Club Show, Obedience Trial or Tracking Test. If a dog is entered in more than one class in one of these events, the AKC Recording Fee and Service Fee is to be collected on the first entry only. (AKC Rules Applying to Dog Shows, Chapter 11, Section 2). An AKC Recording Fee of \$3.00 will be required for each entry in any Licensed or Member Club Rally Trial. If a dog is entered in more than one class in a Rally event, the AKC Recording Fee is to be collected on each of the entries of that dog. (AKC Rally Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 3). All Recording Fees are paid to the American Kennel Club

**OPEN DATE: ENTRIES OPEN September 21, 2022, at 8 AM**

**CLOSING DATE** for entries **November 2, 2022, at 12:00 noon.** A waitlist will be established when limits are reached prior to closing date. From **November 2, 2022, at 12:01 PM to November 14, 2022, at Noon** full refunds will be given for withdrawn entries **ONLY** when a waitlist entry is able to replace withdrawn entry. All other rules from Chapter 11, Section 6 of the Dog Show Rules after which entries cannot be accepted, cancelled or substituted except as stated above.

**TRANSFERS** will be permitted for both Obedience and Rally in accordance with Obedience Regulations, Chapter 1, Section 16a and Chapter 1, Section 15 Rally Regulations. The request for a transfer must be in writing and presented to the Trial Secretary at least 30 minutes prior to the start of the trial. Transfers will be accepted prior to day of trial.

**RETURNED CHECKS & DECLINED CREDIT CARDS** do not constitute a valid entry fee. DDTC will add a \$35.00 collection fee to the amount of each returned check. Subsequent returned checks from the same exhibitors may result in their being put on a CASH ONLY basis.

**ENTRIES RECEIVED WITHOUT FEES** will not be accepted. Telegraph and unsigned entries cannot be accepted. Entries not on official AKC entry forms and photocopies of entry forms without the Agreement and Rules on the reverse side of the Official AKC Entry Form are not acceptable.

**NO REFUND FOR DUPLICATE ENTRIES.** We will make every effort to find all duplicate entries, but if a dog has been processed, no refund will be made.

Refund and Cash award checks are void after 180 days and will NOT be re-issued.

**ERRORS ON ENTRY BLANKS.** Owners are responsible for errors in making out entry forms, whoever may make such errors, and no entry fee will be refunded in event of such errors or cancellation of entries after the published closing date.

**ENTRY FEES** shall not be refunded if a dog is absent, disqualified, excused by Veterinarian or Judge, or barred from competition by action of Show Committee. If because of riots, civil disturbances, pandemics or other acts beyond the control of the management it is impossible to open or to complete the show, no refund of entry fee will be made.

**BITCHES IN SEASON.** Since bitches in season are not permitted to compete in Obedience Trials, all but \$5.00 of the entry fee for bitches unable to compete for that reason, will be refunded. To be eligible for such refund the Trial Secretary must be notified in writing ½ hour or earlier prior to start of first class of the trial together with a veterinarian's certificate on their letterhead confirming the fact that the bitch is in season.

**CONSULT JUDGING PROGRAM FOR TIME OF JUDGING.** All dogs should arrive 15 minutes before judging time. Judges will not wait for any dog holding up a class. Dogs will be judged in catalog order. Owners or agents alone are responsible for the presence of their dogs in the judging ring when their classes are called to be judged. The show-giving club has no obligation or responsibility for providing service through a public address system or stewards or runners for the purpose of calling or locating dogs that are not brought into the ring when requested.

Additionally, I (we) hereby assume the sole responsibility for and agree to indemnify, defend, and save the aforementioned parties harmless from any and all loss and expense (including legal fees) by reason of the liability imposed by law upon any of the aforementioned parties for damage because of bodily injuries, including death at any time resulting therefrom, sustained by any person or persons, including myself (ourselves), or on account of damage to property, arising out of or in consequence of my (our) participation in this event, however such, injuries, death or property damage may be caused, and whether or not the same may have been caused or may be alleged to have been caused by negligence of the aforementioned parties or any of their employees or agents, or any other persons. **I (WE) AGREE THAT ANY CAUSE OF ACTION, CONTROVERSY OR CLAIM ARISING OUT OF OR RELATED TO THE ENTRY, EXHIBITION OR ATTENDANCE AT THE EVENT BETWEEN THE AKC AND THE EVENT-GIVING CLUB (UNLESS OTHERWISE STATED IN ITS PREMIUM LIST) AND MYSELF (OURSELVES) OR AS TO THE CONSTRUCTION, INTREPRETATION AND EFFECT OF THIS AGREEMENT SHALL BE SETTLED BY ARBITRATION PURSUANT TO THE APPLICABLE RULES OF THE AMERICAN ARBITRATION ASSOCIATION. HOWEVER, PRIOR TO ARBITRATION ALL APPLICABLE AKC BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS AND PROCEDURES MUST FIRST BE FOLLOWED AS SET FORTH IN THE AKC CHARTER AND BYLAWS, RULES, REGULATIONS, PUBLISHED POLICIES AND GUIDELINES.**

If, because of riots, civil disturbances, pandemics, catastrophic events including natural or man made or any other acts beyond the control of the clubs and/or Trial Secretary, it is impossible to open or complete the trial, no refund of entry will be made.

## INSTRUCTIONS

- (Variety) if you are entering a dog of breed in which there are varieties for show purposes, please designate the particular variety you are entering, i.e., Cocker Spaniel (solid color black, ASCOB, parti-color), Beagles (not exceeding 13 in., over 13 in. but not exceeding 15 in.), Dachshunds (longhaired, smooth, wirehaired), Collies (rough, smooth), Bull Terriers (colored, white), Manchester Terriers (standard, toy), Chihuahuas (smooth coat, long coat), English Toy Spaniels (King Charles and Ruby, Blenheim and Prince Charles), Poodles (toy, miniature, standard).
- The following categories of dogs may be entered and shown in Best of Breed competition: Dogs that are Champions of Record and dogs which, according to their owners' records, have completed the requirements for a championship, but whose championships are unconfirmed. The showing of unconfirmed Champions in Best of Breed competition is limited to a period of 90 days from the date of the show where the dog completed the requirements for a championship.
- (Event Class) Consult the classification in this premium list. If the event class in which you are entering your dog is divided, then, in addition to designating the class, specify the particular division of the class in which you are entering your dog, i.e., age division, color division, weight division.
- A dog must be entered in the name of the person who actually owned it at the time the entries for a show closed. If a registered dog has been acquired by a new owner it must be entered in the name of its new owner in any event for which entries closed after the date of the acquirement, regardless of whether the new owner has received the registration certificate indicating that the dog is recorded in his name. State on entry form whether transfer application has been mailed to A.K.C. (For complete rule refer to Chapter 11, Section3).
- Mixed Breed Dogs entering classes for Agility, Obedience, and Rally trials should mark Breed as "All-American Dog/Mixed Breed." Sire and Dam information shall remain blank for mixed breed entrant
