September 13 -- 6:00pm – 9:00 pm -- Agility Foundations for Puppies, Young or Inexperienced Dogs

Start your agility off right! Britney will assess where you and your dogs are in your agility journey and help you take the next steps with your training. She will advise each team on how to build and strengthen skills for both the dog and the handler. Course work for young or inexperienced dogs to include basic sequences, jumps and tunnels. Equipment will be added depending on the experience level of the dog.

September 14 -- Lines and Critical Points

Two sessions: 8:30 am – 12:00 noon OR 12:30 pm – 4:00 pm

It's important for all handlers to be able to identify and handle agility lines correctly and critical connection points. Most NQs occur due to a handler not queuing a line correctly or not connecting at a critical point on the dog's line. This half-day seminar will focus on how to identify lines and critical points and how to build those skills. Open to all levels of dogs.

September 15 – Fixing the Holes In Your Handling

Two sessions: 8:30 am – 12:00 noon OR 12:30 pm - 4:00 pm

Skills required for advanced courses will be tested, and we will explore the best handling solutions for you and your dog specifically. Proofing skills and fixing the holes in your handling is imperative to advance as a team. Strengthening commitment points, agility lines and critical connection points, proofing fundamentals of crosses, and extension vs collection are some of the topics that will be covered.

Seminars will be held at 719 Manada Bottom Road in East Hanover Twp., Harrisburg. Our facility is fully matted, heated, air-conditioned, handicapped accessible and situated on five fenced acres. There is plenty of parking and exercise space for dogs.
