8:00am - Noon Agility Foundations for Puppies, Young or Inexperienced Dogs

Start your agility off right! Britney will evaluate your current agility skills and guide you on the next steps in your training. Each team will receive tailored advice to strengthen both handler and dog abilities. Coursework for young or inexperienced dogs will focus on foundational sequences, jumps, and tunnels, with equipment introduced according to the dog's experience level.

1:00pm – 4:00pm Pre Novice and Novice Handling

Skills needed for Novice courses will be tested and explored. Britney will work with each team individually to improve your connection as a handler-dog team. The session will cover proofing skills and addressing gaps in your handling, with tailored solutions for you and your dog.

March 8 --

8:00 – Noon Fixing the Holes in Your Handling

Take your handling to the next level by addressing skills required for advanced courses. This session will test your abilities and focus on finding the best handling solutions for you and your dog. Topics covered include strengthening commitment points, refining agility lines and critical connection points, proofing fundamentals of crosses, and understanding extension versus collection. This session is open to all levels and is essential for teams aiming to advance.

1:00pm - 4:00pm Masters/Premier

Ready for a challenge? This session is designed for handlers and dogs competing at the Excellent or Masters levels. The seminar will present challenges typical of Master/Premier competitions, and Britney will work with each team to identify strengths, pinpoint weaknesses, and provide strategies for improvement.
