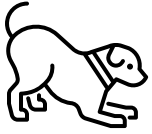

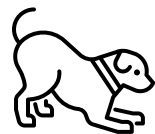

Meeting called to order at 6:25 p.m. at DDTC by President Cindy Miller.

October Board Meeting Minutes stand approved as published if no objections. (Reference Lori's email of 10/21/24.) There were no objections. Minutes approved.

Reports:

President – Cindy Miller

- Please review the September General Membership meeting minutes and the October Annual Meeting minutes. Send corrections to Lori. They will be published in the January annual minutes
- Brief discussion of what trials are registered with AKC for 2025 and what still needs submitted to AKC.
- Lisa would like to go with the first Google calendar she tried last year. She requested trying it on a monthly basis for several months (\$15/mo) before going to an annual plan (reduced rate). Jane moved and Vicki seconded to try the calendar for three months to see if that's what we want to do. Motion carried.
- Also regarding the calendar, Wendy has been using her personal Google log in for the current online calendar. Su pointed out there is also a DDTC log in. Cindy stated that Vicki is in charge of the calendar and needs to be able to update the calendar and both calendars need to sync. All this information will be given to Lisa for consideration as she tries the new calendar.
- Attendance at Annual meeting was UP!! Nikki is willing to do it again next year. Suggestion – two baskets? General agreement to do 2 or 3 baskets and food again. Agreement to donate \$99.99 for baskets to Nikki.
- Thank you to Jane for selling the unused 'stuff' in the small shed!
- Annual Budget Planning Subcommittee – Cindy recommended that this subcommittee be an annual occurrence and suggested it be comprised of Karen, BOD, and maybe a Member at Large. Karen stated she feels strongly that everyone on the board should be involved. To this end, Karen handed out a spreadsheet she had prepared with 2024 numbers. Each line had a person listed on it and that is the key person who will come up with the 2025 budget amount. Karen already reviewed this sheet with Jane. She will have a phone call/emails with each other person listed to determine their amounts. Discussed BOD lines at meeting. Karen reminds everyone that the budget is not binding; it is to be used for planning purposes.
- Annual Review of DDTC Fees Subcommittee – Classes, FOBs, Membership – Recommended members: Karen, Su, Carolyn, Jane, Sharon, Member at Large. Cindy stated that, as we annually review the budget, we should annually review our fees to determine if any changes are needed. Karen recommends doing this review after the budget is finalized so the budget can be used as a backdrop.
- Online Class Registration – Lisa and Karen are reviewing this concept now to see its feasibility and safety of info. Karen has researched how different clubs handle registration. Some use an outside service; some have designed their own process and included it on their websites. She requests that, if you see any club that you like how they do registration, forward that information to Karen/Lisa.
- Master Insurance Building Contents Value – We need a volunteer to keep this list current. Lori volunteered to keep spreadsheet updated. Karen stated she will send Lori the spreadsheet as soon as she finishes updating it.
- Email from Lower Paxton Township to participate in one of their events (9/14/25 4-6 p.m. at Kohl Park) They asked if we could do an agility demonstration? – Cindy said she told them we will get back to them in January. We could possibly set up a few pieces of equipment and allow people to try them with their dogs. Vicki checked that we have an Imhoff clinic scheduled the weekend that was suggested. Lauren recommended we tell them to contact Supporting Paws.
- Zoning Meeting will be held on November 13 at 7 p.m. Su and Cindy will be there. Cindy recommends everyone who can attend should come to support our requests before the Zoning Committee.
- Status Weekly cleaning job description – Lauren

- ✓ Review the times that suit our schedule for the building to be cleaned. Possibly change to Sunday, Monday, or Tuesday evenings so that building can be avail all day Wednesday for agility open training or classes.
- ✓ Cindy requests that Lauren send the job description to board for review.

- Status of scope of work to be done on driveway for water issue
 - ✓ Reviewed cost to repair corner of parking lot which was damaged by trash truck.
 - ✓ Also reviewed the bid John obtained to move mound of dirt and build swale.
 - ✓ Su had previously obtained a quote to move dirt and build swale. Su will ask contractor to update the cost and will forward it to board.
- Status of septic system – Toilets are fixed. If the new toilets do not completely fix the problem, we will need to investigate further to see if we need to put in a baffle.
- Heating system needs fall maintenance which will involve putting ladders up in the building. Vicki gave John several dates that are completely open and maintenance could be performed. John to get back to Vicki with date the contractor will come.

- Match on 11/3 made a profit of \$870.

- October Tracking Trial lost \$303.80. (A loss is expected at tracking trials due to the limited number of competitors in a day.)
- October Scentwork made a profit of \$1650.94. Jane noted that Tammy Allwein and Lynn Hostetler got West Hanover Township for the July 2025 scentwork trial.
- Jane did the 2025 Obedience class schedule two months ago. She feels strongly that the entire 2025 schedule should be on the online calendar, not just listed on the website under classes.
- Instructors – John Cirillo has instructed for 50 years; Ruth Ann for 43 years; Theresa for 32 years; Judy Fegan more than 30 years.
